



MP PRESSES SUPERMARKET CHAIN FOR DECISION

North Tyneside constituency MP, Mary Glindon, has added her voice to those of other local residents in demanding that Morrison's declare their intentions for their proposed supermarket in Wallsend.

Mary says, "until Morrison's give a firm date for the opening of their proposed new store in Wallsend town centre, neither local people nor North Tyneside Council can have any confidence in the company's intentions. I am concerned because Wallsend desperately needs a new supermarket to keep the town centre alive, which would be an impetus for the regeneration of Wallsend as a whole."

She added, "as the MP I have addressed my concerns directly to the Chief Executive of Morrison's and will pursue this issue until I get a conclusive answer for my constituents in Wallsend."

Morrison's Chief Executive has promised to respond to the MP's concerns and Mary Glindon hopes to arrange a meeting with one of the Director's as soon as possible.
